

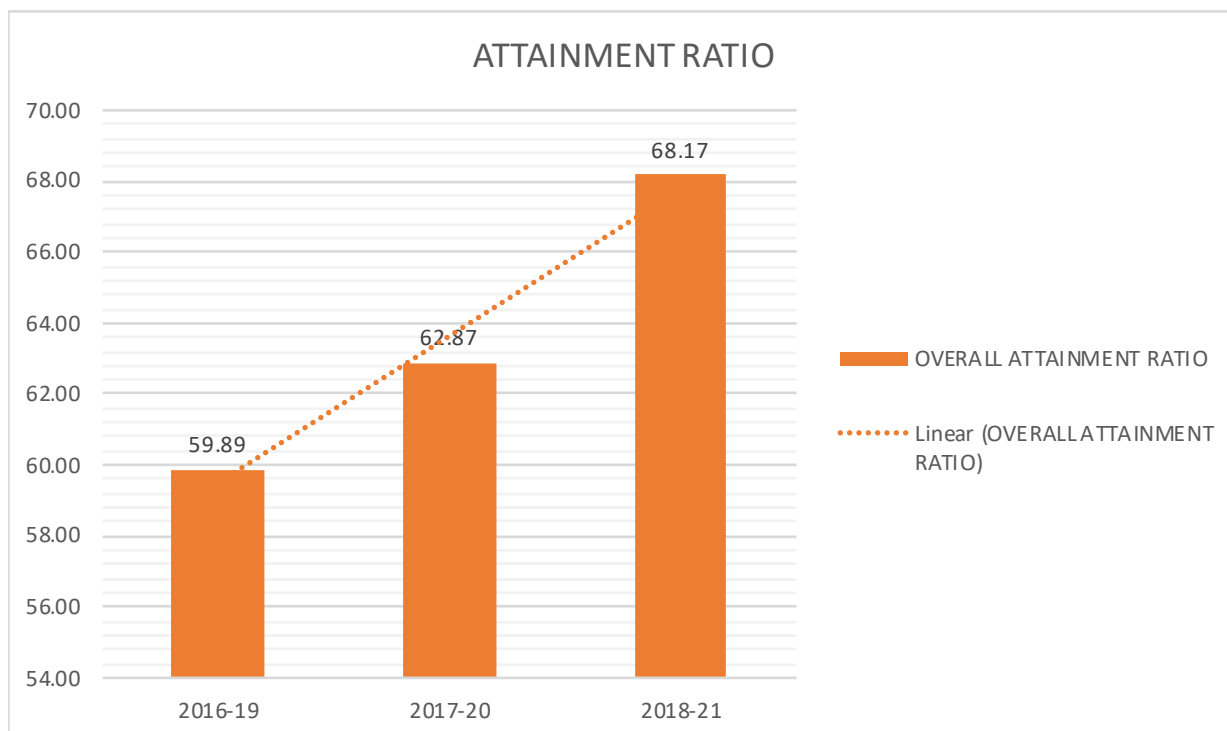
ATTAINMENT RATIO

Attainment is the gap between what is taught and what is understood. As per the suggestion in the two days National Workshop on NEW AQAR Guidelines 2020, 2nd & 3rd December 2021, organized by Lady Irwin College, University of Delhi.

Attainment Ratio has been calculated for last three years to assess the attainment of programme and course outcomes in the college.

The attainment Ratio can be calculated by summing up the scores of students and dividing the total by the number of students who appeared for the course.
