
1) Members agreed that the academic program of the college should ensure that the newly introduced CBCS structure is implemented properly.

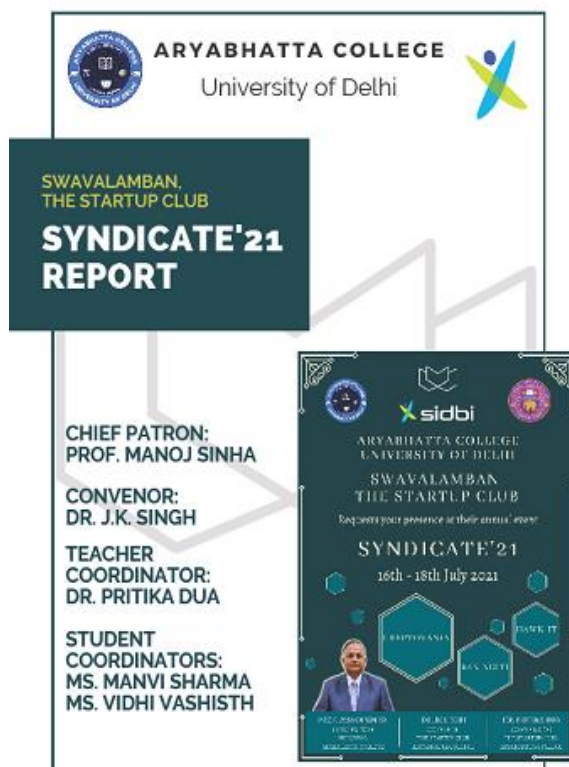
