1	It is observed that the response has been fairly non-symmetrically distributed across departments with maximum response from the economics department, followed by English, Psychology and Computer Science.	All the concerned Departments would be directed to look into the reasons and take necessary steps for encouraging their Alumini in responding any such form circulated by the college in future.
2	Maximum response came from students who passed out in 2021, followed by 2020. The responsiveness declined as the year of passing out moved away towards 1990's. This shows that students who had passed out much earlier were either difficult to reach out or were reluctant to post a response to the feedback.	The committee observed the trend and suggested the Alumini Committee to take adequate measures to in contacting students passed out in earlier years and invite them in college programs/seminars/functions, etc. via emails and other mode of communication.
3	48% alumni strongly agrees that they gained adequate knowledge during their course of study at Aryabhatta College. 39% alumni agree about the same. About 2% of respondents disagree or strongly disagree. 11% students are neutral about the question	The committee decided to continue with its efforts towards curriculum enrichment and improvement of teaching pedagogy though augmentation in the use of ICT enabled tools, conducting seminars, workshops, etc.
4	33% alumni strongly agrees that the knowledge they gained in the course of their study at Aryabhatta College proved relevant to their job/current profession/start-up. 33% alumni agree about the same. About 8% of respondents disagree or strongly disagree. 25% students are neutral about the question.	The committee decided to update our faculty members associated with the organization of various ADD ON courses and suitably include courses which can take care of this aspect.
5	63% alumni strongly agrees that the faculty members were co-operative about academic support and overall development. 27% alumni agree about the same. About 3% of respondents disagree or strongly disagree. 7% students are neutral about the question.	The cooperation of faculty members towards students and its acknowledgement by large proportion of students was appreciated by the committee.

6	33% alumni strongly agrees that the administration has been responsive to their queries and concerns. 34% alumni agree about the same. About 11% of respondents disagree or strongly disagree. 22% students are neutral about the question.	The cooperation of Administration staff towards students and its acknowledgement by majority of students was appreciated by the committee. The committee ,however, decided to apprise the Administration Department with the feedback given by the students alongwith the suggestion to take appropriate measures in improving their functioning towards students.
7	41% alumni would be strongly interested in delivering a guest lecture/a special talk, or in conducting a motivational session for their juniors. 22% alumni agree about the same. About 14% of respondents disagree or strongly disagree. 24% students are neutral about the question.	The intent of large proportion of Alumini towards their involvement as Guest lecture/special talk was taken on record and the committee decided to apprise all faculty members to consider the same for the events due to be conducted in future.
8	60% alumni would strongly recommend their friends or relatives for enrolment in Aryabhata College. 28% alumni agree about the same. About 3% of respondents disagree or strongly disagree. 9% students are neutral about the question.	The opinion of Alumini regarding college was appreciated and the committee decided to initiate further steps towards curriculum enrichment and personality development of students by way of organizing seminars/workshops/experiential and participative learning/capacity building programs, etc.
