
#### **Teachers' Feedback 2021-22**

An educational institution that aspires for excellence stands strong on the pillars of updated infrastructure, good administration, an academically conducive environment that provides opportunities for personal & professional growth as well as organisational culture consisting of habits and behaviours of its employees towards each other. From the year 2015-16, the college initiated the process of collecting feedback from teachers regarding academic satisfaction and their inputs about college infrastructure which would help the college to improve its facilities for the future. The college earlier existed as Ram Lal Anand College (Evening) and turned into a morning college as Aryabhatta College in the academic session 2015-16. The college decided in 2016-17 to collect feedback from both teachers and students. It was decided to collect feedback from teachers by requesting them to fill out a form which would reflect their opinion about academic environment, infrastructure in the college. In the year 2020-21, there were 89 responses recorded out of which 19 teachers were Associate Professors and the rest 71 were Assistant Professors. Some of the basic observations that were recorded from the questionnaire are presented in the forms of graphs below:

**Q1.** The syllabus responds to the emerging research and practical application needs of the field.



**Q2.** The ICT (Information and Communications Technology) facilities in the College create a technologically upgraded pedagogical environment.



**Q3.** The college has a good network of CCTV cameras covering all the important areas of the campus.



Q4. The library staff is efficient and well behaved in their dealing with teachers and students.



**Analysis**: Around 70% faculty members agree that the library staff is efficient and well behaved in their dealing with teachers and students; 21% are neutral and 14% disagree.


**Q5.** The accounts staff is efficient and well behaved in their dealing with teachers and students.






**Q7.** The college is able to offer you a high level of job satisfaction and a conducive academic environment








**Analysis**: 60% of the faculty members believe that the college canteen is able to serve hygienic and nutritious food; 45% disagree and 35.7% are neutral.

**Q9.** Your department is supportive and provides you a stress-free working environment.



Analysis: More than 81% of the faculty members believe that their respective departments are supportive and provide them a stress-free working environment.


