There have been suggestions given by students that the teaching learning methods needs a change in view of the implementation of the NEP. • To improve the participative learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The college had a series of discussions and meetings with the teachers about how teaching pedagogy can be improved. Teachers have been motivated to adopt new teaching method like flip classroom, article review, real time quiz etc. Teachers are advised to give exposure of role model, buddy system etc to improve participative learning.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Some students of departments have suggestions with respect to punctuality of classes and irregularity and inconsistency in the conduct of the classes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The college made a note of this and wherever students expressed dissatisfaction, those issues were addressed by talking to the teacher-in- charges/ individual teachers concerned. Notices to this effect are taken out on a monthly basis & monthly submission and uploading of attendance is also ensured.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To enrich library resources with online / offline study material. <p>Some students seem to be dissatisfied with the library resource material and administration.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New text and reference books were purchased for library enrichment. • All departments were requested to note their respective requirements and inform the library about the purchases to be made. • Library staff was trained to improve their mode of dealing with the students by the IQAC and at the same time have been advised to be strict with the students who disturb the regular activities there.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide a greater number of placement opportunities & career counselling session. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students' placement activity has to be strengthened by improving industry linkages and ensuring more collaborations. Some departments like business economics, management studies, commerce etc. have been motivated to devise ways to increase industrial participation in absorbing our students. These methods can involve regular industry seminars, interaction with corporates and more industrial visits by placement cell members.

- Some departments do not hold mentoring sessions regularly and for some, these sessions are not effective.

- All these departments have been advised to mentor their respective groups in a more effective manner, as under the NEP, this is a required mandate.
