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SEMINAR ON CAREER COUNSELLING

(14th OCTOBER, 2022)

On 14th October 2022, TechPioneers, the Computer Science society of Aryabhata College organized a **Career Counselling Seminar** for students who are currently pursuing computer science as their core or elective subject. The seminar, which marked the beginning of the 2022-23 session was conducted in collaboration with Landmark Institute, a popular institute for MCA coaching. The guest speaker for the seminar was Prof. Ritukar Chadha, Director of Landmark Institute. Fifty two (52) students from different disciplines attended the seminar.

Objective

The session was conducted with the aim to familiarise students with the range of career opportunities that computer science offers and what can be the roadmap to get their foot in these companies as they are known to offer excellent perks and professional growth opportunities. Pursuing MCA as a postgraduate degree was mainly focused upon by the speaker.

The Speaker

Prof. Ritukar Chadha is a professional educationist, businessman and the director of Landmark Institute. He is a Ph.D. in mathematics and has worked in several colleges affiliated with GGSIP University. He has had a distinguished and accomplished career and has written a number of books on Advanced Mathematics including BCA Mathematics (Vol I, II, III, IV) for GGSIP University and also for various universities of Uttar Pradesh. The books include varied subject areas in maths namely calculus, Discrete Mathematics, Statistics and Operation Research, Real Analysis, etc.

Summary of the Seminar

The session started with encouraging words of Ms. Mona Adlakha who pressed upon the need of gaining knowledge in every sphere of life and to keep growing by implementing that knowledge. Dr. Priti Jagwani, Teacher-in-Charge, Dept. of Computer Science facilitated the speaker- Prof. Ritukar Chadha. Landmark Institute is a renowned institute known over the whole of North India for imparting quality coaching for the MCA Entrance Exam.

Following the facilitation, the speaker delivered their keynote, emphasizing the relevance and necessity of coming out of our comfort zone to achieve what we potentially deserve.
