

NSS organised breast cancer awareness programme for women.

Fortis hospital surgeon was invited by the NSS unit of the college to educate the faculty and students of symptoms, diagnosis, prevention of breast cancer amongst women. The programme was aimed addressing the issue of breast cancer amongst women in the demanding lifestyle era.
