






LIFE CHANGING OPPURTUNITIES (16TH FEBRUARY 2023)

The factory representative provided detailed information on manufacturing capacity, quality checks, raw material sourcing, distribution, processes, and production variety. Students visited Amul's milk and cottage-cheese manufacturing unit, learning about robotics, human-friendly machines, and software. The Faridabad plant processes 85% milk from Gujrat and DELHI-NCR region, arriving in Delhi via special trains and trucks. Students learned about Amul's effective Supply Chain Management techniques, enabling the company to be a top milk producer and distributor globally, using high-tech software for global connectivity.
