# The Entrepreneurship Cell, Aryabhatta College Participated in Principium's Start-Up Bootcamp Webinar

A start-up bootcamp webinar was held by **Principium Advisory on January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021** from 10am onwards. The webinar was divided into 4 different panels with entrepreneurs from varying fields sharing their knowledge and expertise with the participants. The webinar was attended by more than 100 participants and gave an insight into the life of entrepreneurs.

The **Welcome address** was given by **Ms**. **Sangeeta Thakur and Mr**. **Puneet Mathur** to inform the participants about the schedule for the day and to mark the beginning of event proceedings.

#### Panel 1 (10:15am-11:40am)

- The first panel included Mr. Anupam Agrawal, Founder, FORTE India, Mr. Parantap Shekhar, Founder and Director, Parantap Shekhar (Designer), Captain Suresh Sharma, Green Dot expeditions and Ms. Vibha Ajmani, VAADA enterprises. The panel discussion was moderated by Mr. Shankar Sahay.
- The panelists shared their experience of starting their journey, the impact of covid-19 on their ventures, their future plans for their respective organizations and the effect of IT on their ventures.
- The session was concluded by asking for piece of advice for aspiring entrepreneurs and a quick Q&A session.



### Panel 2 (11:45am-1:00pm)

- The second panel included Mr. Kaushik Basu, Founder, Himalayan Nectar, Ms. Ritu Jain, Founder, Śūnnya Kalāshram and Ms. Sonali Korde, Samsona Getaways. The panel discussion was moderated by Mr. Puneet Mathur.
- The panelists introduced their ventures, shared their motivation to get into entrepreneurship, explained key learnings at the beginning of their journey, gave advice on finding the right markets and convincing customers.
- The session concluded with a couple of Q&As and summary of topics discussed by the moderator.
