He has conducted multiple seminars and workshops for promoting Entrepreneurship and Skill development in several institutes. Mr Ajay, recently finished his engineering and started his own venture, **Honest Farmer**, in an alliance with Mr Gahlot.

Students had an interactive session with the speakers and the members of the society. Few budding entrepreneurs of the college who had already started their ventures briefed the audiences about their entrepreneurial journey and shared the challenges and rewards of being an entrepreneur. Students gained widely in the domain of entrepreneurship and many were seen visibly motivated to start their own ventures.
