

## Report on Orientation Programme for Selection of papers in SEM 3 under NEP

The Department of Business Economics successfully organized an online orientation programme for the **selection of papers in Semester 3 under NEP** (New Educational Policy) on 8<sup>th</sup> August through the online Google Meet platform. The teacher in charge for the same was **Mr. Harish Dhawan**. The session aimed at informing the students about the choices in the papers they are having in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester.

The session began with all the faculty members and students greeting each other. The first thing about which Mr. Harish Dhawan informed students was the choices in papers they had. In 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, students can **choose any one** of the two papers i.e. **DSE** (**Discipline Specific Elective**) and **GE** (**Generic Elective**). DSE is the elective paper offered by the main / core discipline subject i.e. offered by department of the course you are pursuing graduation in. DSE of other course or other discipline in GE i.e. elective paper offered by department of other courses in which you are not pursuing graduation. The student who will choose **7 GE papers offered by same department** would earn a **MINOR degree** in that subject which would help him/her to develop career in that subject in future.

The DSE offered for 3<sup>rd</sup> semester by Department of Business Economics is Entrepreneurship which aims at developing entrepreneurial skills of the students and make them understand various aspects of entrepreneurship. On other hand GE offered by various departments comprises a pool of 9 papers, each offered by different Departments of College which aims at providing the students opportunity to diversify their knowledge and skills.

The session was further carried on by informing the second choice they have in 3<sup>rd</sup> semester i.e. the choice between **SEC** (**Skill Enhancement Course**) and **IAPC** (**Internship/Apprenticeship/Project/Community Outreach**). SEC aims at providing hands-on-training, competencies, proficiency and skills to students whereas IAPC provides 4 different platforms for learning and developing practical skills by working on-field like doing internships or apprenticeships or initiating a project or working for community welfare.

**30** students attended the session and thus availed the benefits of the session. The students now have a better vision about pros and cons of all the options available. This session helped them all to take a well-thought decision about the papers they will chose in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester.
