PRATIVAD 3.0





Motion: THBT with the spread of COVID-19 and subsequent lockdown, India has witnessed the weakening of its democratic pillars.



There were cash prizes & certificates for the following positions in Round 1. Participation certificates were to be awarded to all the participants.


Best Speaker - English.


FINAL ROUND
