ELIGIBILITY:

The applicant should be a bonafide student pursuing Graduation/Post Graduation Course from a recognized College/University of India.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS:

- Poster/Painting/Drawing must be on paper of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) or A2 size (420 x 594 mm).
- Acceptable tools of drawing/painting include pencil, crayon, water color, oil paint, etc. Photographs, wires, 3D objects, Computers are not acceptable.
- The Poster/Painting/Drawing must not include words, national flags, or slogans.
- The Poster/Painting/Drawing must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name and must not depict any religious theme.
- The above selected theme should be the main focus of the Poster/Painting/Drawing.
- No text (including theme title, name, etc) should be written on the front of the Poster/Painting/Drawing.
- A Poster/Painting/Drawing should be an individual effort of a student.
- All artworks must be original ideas.

- The completed artwork must be on a flat piece of paper.
- The art work received through this competition will become the property of NPC and it will be used for further propagation and dissemination of concept or idea presented to the masses. The applicant will have no claim on the art work henceforth.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

- All Poster/Painting/Drawing shall be evaluated on presentation and novelty of the idea.
- The best three entries (Poster/Painting/Drawing)will be selected by a Committee of Experts/Jury from the total paintings received by Regional Directorate-Delhi for Award of Selection at regional level.

AWARD OF SELECTION:

The students of best three entries (Poster/Painting/Drawing) in Delhi region of NPC Regional Directorate shall be invited for felicitation on Foundation Day Celebration i.e. 12th February 2019.

AWARD PRIZE:

- The student of the best three Poster/Painting/Drawing shall be awarded a Memento by Regional Directorate Delhi, NPC.
