
### **DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH**



# International Webinar & Departmental Festival, Calypso (26th -27th February, 2021)



### INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE

### Ongoing Construction of the New Academic Block:

Despite the persistent delays due to the surge in Covid-19 cases in the city, and the subsequent suspension of construction work, the 4-storey academic and administrative blocks are close to hand-over stage constituting a covered area of 4800 and 2800 sq. m., respectively. Meanwhile, the college has obtained all necessary approvals from local bodies for construction of three additional floors in the two buildings, thereby augmenting the existing covered area by 5700 sq. m. The tender for the same has been awarded by the CPWD and the work awaits commencement.

### **Electric Substation and Sewage Treatment Plant:**

**Electric Substation:** The work of creation of the HT and LT rooms with transformers and metering sections has been taken up jointly with the RLA College. The project is being implemented by the CPWD and is expected to be completed by December 2021.

**Sewage Treatment Plant:** The project has been conceptualized with the RLA College to prevent duplication of amenities. Order for the provision of a 30 KLD plant has been given to the CPWD for implementation. The project is at the stage of designing and floating of tender, expected to be completed within the present financial year.

The Gender Sensitisation Committee worked in close and continuous coordination with students across disciplines to organize (online) awareness and sensitisation workshops to sensitize participants w.r.t. gender equality practices at the workplace.

### NIBS AND BRUSHES, Creative Writing and Fine Arts Society




