INTRODUCTION

Looking back on the academic year 2017-18, I am happy to say that it has been an extremely packed one in terms of events, activities and a variety of developments. At the same time it has also been an extremely fulfilling one. As Aryabhatta turns four since its inception, it is a matter of extreme pride to witness the incremental growth, and more significantly, to be a part of that formative transition that will shape the future of Aryabhatta College.

Today, as we celebrate the 4th Annual College Day, the occasion demands that we take a stock of things done, review the progress made and acknowledge the achievements of our students, faculty members and the non-teaching staff.

Looking back in retrospect, we are thrilled to have witnessed a new surge of energy that has resulted in noticeable developments in the College.

INFRASTRUCTURE

With the onset of monsoon in 2017, we created the lawn and the stepped outdoor seating at the Taregna Block. Members of the college and visitors alike have admired its aesthetics and comfort. The new computer laboratory with 48 terminals, a faculty research room with 12 workstations, extension of projection facility from 3 classrooms to 23 classrooms was achieved during the year. All these have found appreciation and are in regular use.

The current ongoing work includes the construction of the four-storey twin College Buildings which is expected to be completed by the summer of 2019, funded jointly by the UGC and the University of Delhi. A covered space for the storage of office records and repair of storage cabinets is underway. A number of projects are slated to be completed before the beginning of the academic session in July 2018. These include an additional computer laboratory with 43 terminals, an additional storey on the roof of the existing Taregna Block to house five classrooms and four additional rooms as well as proper furnishing of the library reading room, girls' common room, the canteen dining hall and the new administrative building.

There are also two new projects still in the designing and approval stage over which the Infrastructure committee has spent a reasonable amount of time. These are the provision of three additional floors for the four-storey twin College Buildings and the development of the sports field and facilities. Both these projects are expected to commence implementation around the end of this calendar year.

ADD-ON COURSE

Aryabhatta College successfully conducted an Add-on course titled "Advance Skill Programme on Financial Markets" in collaboration with Advanced Institute of Financial Markets and Research (AIFMR) under the flagship of NIESBUD, an organisation of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government of India during October 2017 — March 2018. This course helped in creating the knowledge and insights on Financial Markets and was successfully concluded on 16 March 2018 by awarding certification to 70 students from various courses of Aryabhatta college and other colleges of University of Delhi.

It is prudent to remind that one course with Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) was concluded successfully and the next course on "Advance Program in Financial Modelling" in collaboration with I.M.S. Pro School under the flagship of NSDC, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship is already underway.

ADVENTURE SOCIETY

In seeking to explore terrains beyond academics, the Adventure Society conducted two Himalayan trek expeditions, introducing the students to the serenity of nature and the spirit of team work. It also provided opportunity for students to interact with residents. The first expedition involved six days of trekking to Darwa Pass via Dayara meadow and Dodital Lake in Bhatwari-Uttarkashi districts of Uttarakhand starting 27 September 2017. 48 students participated. The second expedition with 74 students trekked for 2 days in March 2018 to Tunganath- Chandrashila via Chopta and Ukhimat in the Rudraprayag district of Uttrakhand. Our college is among a handful that organize trekking, and no other college has done so for 28 years without a break.

"CONNECT 18" the first North East Inter-College Festival

Aryabhatta College is aware of the diversity of our cultures and celebrates this plurality. In keeping with this spirit, the first North East Inter-College Festival was hosted by the North East Society of Aryabhatta College under the name of "Connect 18" was held from 19th to 23rd March 2018 in the Aryabhatta College. The festival was fully funded by the Ministry of Development of North East Region (DoNER), Government of India. The Grand event day was graced by Chief Guest Prof. Bhagat Oinam, Centre for Philosophy, School of Social Sciences, JNU, New Delhi. It was marked by different sports and games and various cultural and traditional elements in the form of folk dances and attire show, solo singing and photography. The festival was concluded with a musical evening perform by a well known Northeast band 'Traffic Jam". A large number of enthusiastic students from across the different Delhi University colleges came and participated in the five days festival.

educating them on how to cope up stress and importance of Ayurveda and Herbal products in managing stress and anxiety related problems.

A Two- Day Entrepreneurship Summit was organized on 5th and 6th April 2018. The DAY 1 of the E-Summit kicked off with Speaker sessions by the stalwarts of the industry that included talks by Mr. Sanjay Mann (CEO Reliance Communications (G.E.B.), Mr. Raman Bhatia (MD Servotech Power Systems), Mr. Vinayak Nath (MD Unicron Group, Managing Partner, Venture Catalysts - India's Biggest Early Stage Investors Angel Investor, Mentor - Govt of UP and Niti Aayog. Incubator Selection Committee Member: SCIFI by SIDBI & IIM Lucknow and IIIC IIIT Allahabad.), Mr. Deep Bajaj (Founder &CEO –PEEBUDDY), Mr. Vaibhav Nanda (Entrepreneur), Mr. Harshit Gupta (Social Entrepreneur, Founder-Womenite).

The Business Model Canvas Workshop in coordination with Pro-wisdom Growth was organized on Day-1 for the participants of the B-Plan Competition and other young aspirants. The feedback was immensely positive. The short certification workshop helped students convert ideas into actual businesses.

The DAY 2 of the summit witnessed a stellar B-Plan Competition. Major Investors included: Mr. Vinayak Nath (Co-Founder and Managing Partner at Venture Catalysts), Mr. Amit Jain(Co-founder at Nemesis Consultants & We Care Finance), Mr. Sameer Gupta (Director at Future First Global FZ LLC), and Mr. Rachit Mathur (Co-Founder & CEO at Avenue Growth). The event was a huge success as all our investors are taking equity and adding three B-Plan Entries (Parking Pass, DLVRY, IBT) to their portfolio for an undisclosed amount. Furthermore, two of our investors have shown keen interest in "Yule Hole" the B-Plan entry from a team of Aryabhatta college students. Our summit ended on a successful note as students were exposed to the start-up and VC culture. Students witnessed what it takes to convert an idea to a B-Plan and then a start-up.

GANDHI STUDY CIRCLE

Gandhi Study Circle of Aryabhatta College organized several activities for creating awareness and interest in Gandhi's life and work among students as well as faculty members. GSC invited eminent scholars to speak on Gandhi's thought, practices and his relevance; conducted a Student and faculty visit to National Gandhi Museum and Library, New Delhi as well as Rajghat; and initiated a series called "Faculty Talk" wherein college faculty members spoke on a particular facet of Gandhi's life and work and interacted with the students in round table format. Various eminent personalities were invited throughout the year to deliver lectures on Gandhi.

GARDEN AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

A lot of initiatives were taken by the committee to enhance environmental awareness and for development of green and environment friendly campus. This year the committee organized two plantation drives. In its first drive, the Principal along with faculty members and students planted various timber plants and in the second drive seasonal and evergreen saplings were planted.

The lawns of Taregna block were developed into lush green grasslands. Like every year, this year too waste papers were converted into note pads and paper reams in association with "Jagruti – a waste paper recycling NGO".

GENDER SENSITIZATION COMMITTEE

The Gender Sensitization Committee worked actively to promote the motto of GSC; to instill equality, dignity and safety amongst students and employees of the college. The committee initiated talks, discussions and workshops and coordinated with NGOs to install a sanitary vending machine in the Girl's common room.

HINDI

The Hindi department organized a debate on the topic 'Jammu Kashmir mein dhara 370 prasangik hai" and three best speakers were awarded.

MARKETING CELL

The Marketing Cell did not just limit its efforts towards the field of expertise, but branched its operations in other fields as well. Established this year itself, Marketing Cell has cemented its name in the university. The Marketing Cell represented the college on various levels and competitions throughout the university and proved successful in their endeavors. The Marketing Cell partnered with many of the biggest societies of other colleges and was the marketing partners for some of the biggest events at the college and university level including TEDx Aryabhatta College, Enactus Day 2.0.

The Marketing Cell also organized one of the biggest events of the college EXULT'17, the first ever marketing fest of Aryabhatta College which gathered an audience of more than 200+ students and brought in investments and partnerships from some of the biggest names in the industry including Facebook. EXULT'17 comprised of some of the biggest and most successful events of the college including the first ever Stand-Up comedy and

Start-Ab by JOSH Talks. Marketing Cell also provided some students with lucky rewards including paid internship at Innolabz.

Throughout the year, The Marketing Cell organized various informative sessions, workshops and seminars on different topics ranging from 'What after Graduation, Vedic Math, A guide to scoring 100 percentile in CAT, AI and Robotics and many more. The Marketing Cell along with the Placement Cell also organized the Internship Fair'18, one of the biggest events in Delhi University bringing in Internships of various fields from around the country bringing opportunities for more than 300 students and helping more than 50 students score internships in their fields of interest and kick starting their careers by introducing them to the corporate world in various companies including MTV, Viacom18, TheMoneyRoller, WebShuttle etc.

MUSIC SOCIETY

The Music Society of our College, Music Gateway led an active journey this year. They successfully conducted their Fest, Ecstasy '18, which was well-attended by students across the University. Our College team won the first prize at Dayal Singh College, third prize at ARSD college in the Battle of Bands. They won the second prize in Group Singing at IIT, Delhi and at PGDAV, Khalsa colleges of Delhi University. The Classical singing group of our society won the second position in a competition organised by Indian Embassy and Cultural Centre and clinched the 1st position at Swami Shraddhanand college.

NATIONAL SOCIAL SERVICE

NSS Unit organised various activities, seminars and camps throughout the academic session 2017-18. Aryabhatta College celebrated 'International Day of Yoga' on 21st June 2017 and Special Electoral Camp was organised in the month of July, 2017. Various activities like "Swachhta Abhiyan", "Swachhta Pakhwara" Campaign, "Quit India Movement" were organised in the month of August and September, 2017. NSS Unit organized Pledge Ceremony and Unity Run for college students and staff on occasion of birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. Vigilance Awareness Week was observed from 30 October- 4 November 2017 and a Debate Competition was organised on "Who Should be more Vigilant: State or Citizen in a Democracy". College also celebrated "Constitution Day" on 26 November 2017. In 2018, National Youth Day was observed on 12 January and National Voters Day on 25 January. Matribhasha Diwas was also celebrated on 21 February, 2018, a day to promote and disseminate mother tongue and the awareness of the cultural traditions throughout the world.

NIBS & BRUSHES: The Fine Arts & Creative Writing Society

It has two wings working in collaboration- a Fine Arts wing consisting of sketch artists and painters and a Creative Writing wing formed by young budding poets and storytellers of Aryabhatta College. Frequent meetings were held to keep the members updated on various happenings and also to have a fun time reading self-written poetry and exhibiting the artworks. In addition, the team organized Slam Poetry and Sketching competition.

PICWIC: THE PHOTOGRAPHY SOCIETY

Aiming to expand and explore the creative and visual horizons through the lens, members of PICWIC, the Film and Photography Society of Aryabhatta College took part in various activities across Delhi.

PLACEMENT and INTERNSHIP CELL

The Placement & Internship Cell of Aryabhatta College has been successful in providing placements to 42 students across different courses. Companies like Convergys, Genpact, IIM jobs, HSBC Bank, Tommy Hilfiger, Alight Solutions, Greenpeace India came for placement drives with CTC ranging from 2.0 lacs to 4.2 lacs in the academic session 2017-2018. The on-campus internship drive by Paperboat Pvt ltd, selected 23 girls from various courses for their internship programme. Placement and Internship Cell successfully concluded the First Internship Fair in the history of Aryabhatta College. With the aim of making students career's stand out, the team worked together to bring 30+ companies with varied profiles for the students of the University of Delhi. The event hosted 300+ students from 25+ different colleges and other Delhi based universities successfully. Under the personality development project "Headstart", various sessions on GD & PI were conducted to develop the vocal skills of the students to face interviews. These sessions were organised in association with various educational and other institutions like Unique Shiksha, ICEBalaji

production which were attended by 120+ students on an average. Various sessions on how to crack IAS, Civil services entrances, Corporate Social responsibility were also conducted and effectively appreciated by students.

POLITICAL SCIENCE SOCIETY

The department organized two days National Seminar on 'Hill Valley Connection in North East India' on 5th- 6th January 2018. The programme was supported by ICSSR, ICPR and Ministry of Development of North East Region, Government of India. Twenty research Papers were presented, and forty-five delegates participated and served as Chair and cochair in the seminar. The following Talks were also organized by the department:

RANGMANCH

As always, our theatre group *Rangmanch* had a very active 2017-2018 with numerous performances across Delhi. *Rangmanch* performed their Street-Play, *Mansickta* at various college fests and participated in a workshop on shadow puppetry. Their stage play, *Nirala*, won appreciation and they performed it at TEDX Aryabhatta event and at other university events, including Theatre Festival of Rashtriya Kala Manch, ASMITA College Drama Festival, and Amity University. *Rangmanch* received the Best Director award at Udaan Theatre Festival this year.

Transcending departmental boundaries, some of the events that had the entire college faculty participating in it to create a more holistic environment are:

a) PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Setting a new benchmark a 5 day Personality Development Programme was conducted for the third time for the benefit of BA (Prog.) students which had faculty members from various disciplines participating in it including the Principal himself who delivered lectures and presentations. The programme aimed at overall development of students' personality including English proficiency enhancement and body language thereby preparing them for an entry into a world of jobs and professionalism. Students' feedback on this has been extremely encouraging.

b) 'VASUDHAIVA KUTUMBAKAM – AN INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR:

The College in collaboration with ABRSM and the Shaikshik Foundation organized a two day international seminar titled 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' on 24th-25th February 2018 at the NDMC Convention Centre, New Delhi. The seminar was supported by the UGC,

ICSSR, ICHR, ICPR and the Indian Oil Corporation. In three parallel sessions, about 120 research papers were presented by various scholars from India and abroad, making it a grand academic success. The Seminar was graced by Sushree Uma Bharti, Honorable Minister for Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India; and Shri J.P. Nadda, Honorable Minister for Health & Family Welfare, Government of India besides several bureaucrats, Vice-chancellors, overseas participants and technical experts.

c) 1ST SAVITRIBAI PHULE MEMORIAL LECTURE

Aryabhatta College organized the 1st Savitribai Phule Memorial lecture in partnership with Nehru Memorial Museum and Library, New Delhi on 21st March 2018. The lecture was intended as a tribute to Phule, a social reformer and a poet who worked tirelessly for the upliftment of women cutting across caste and gender hierarchies. It laid the foundation for commemorating a lineage of powerful ideas of strong Indian women.

STUDENTS' COUNCIL

The students council of Aryabhatta college successfully discharged its role as representative body of the students in the corporate life of the college under the presidentship of Pratibha Yadav. Based on the principle of combining democratic election and academic excellence among the students of the college, students council has offered a deliberative space to the students of the college to hone their leadership qualities and argumentative skills through their regular participation in the council meetings which have been marked by well reasoned debates among the students.
