Ram Lal Anand College (Evening) has been converted into a full-fledged day college and has been renamed as Aryabhata College from the Academic Year 2014-15. Today the College with over 2200 Students 75 Faculty members and 30 Non-Teaching Staff members forms the strength of this institution.

The Annual Prize Distribution Function of this academic year (2014-15) is very special to all because this is the First Annual Day Function of Aryabhata College which is a matter of both pride and pleasure. We are extremely pleased to have a new name ARYABHATTA COLLEGE with a new building and entirely new hopes and aspirations to do some new, necessary and significant work for the young generation and the entire nation.

Now, we are a day college and going to change our identity from the coming session this July and we hope that we will reorient our priorities to provide equal opportunities to everyone. So far, the evening colleges have not been the priority of the girls students but this time, we hope to provide a better place for co-education facilities.

Today we have 7 courses in our College. We are very keen to bring 4-5 new honours courses to offer our students a wider range of choice for the subjects. The expansion/modification of the existing facilities and creation of new facilities have always been a matter of great concern to the College as well as to the University. Therefore, the College completely regards, cooperates and assists the disabled teaching, non-teaching staff members and the students and it has taken radical steps to make its premises, offices and other facilities disabled friendly. The new semi-permanent structures have been constructed by strictly following the same parameters. In the age of information technology and increasing use of the audio-visual teaching- learning facilities, the modification of the classrooms have been undertaken by installing projectors, screen-cum-whiteboards and new furniture not only to facilitate the students but to create a world class standard as well.

In view of the new guidelines for the teachers, this institution is committed to provide good facilities to the teacher so that their resourcefulness can be increased and made available to the students easily. Arrangements for resources and information centre are being made in the new building which will help the teachers to develop their skills to the desired levels. Deepika Sehrawat, B.Com I, Soumya Basnet, Eng (H) I won Gold Medal in Fly and Bantom weight categories whereas their teammates Sumedha Rathi B.A (P) I, and Husna Siddiqui

English (H) I, won Silver Medals in fly and feather weight categories. Their brilliant performance can be seen from the fact that these two girls later represented University of Delhi at the All India Inter University Championship organized by AIU.

Deepika also won Gold Medal at the all India level and helped University of Delhi to be placed third as a team at the all India level. Soumya also represented University of Delhi at the all India championship.

The college earlier has sent these two girls to Pune for open nationals where Deepika was winners in Fly weight category and Soumeya won silver in Feather weight categories. Cricket

The college cricketers did achieve a lot but there is always room for improvement Pulkit Narang BC III, Rohit Dubey BA (P) and Karan Dagar B.A (P) I were selected to represent University of Delhi this year not only university's team won the North Zone Championship (Where all most 40 top Universities of Northern India participated but also were declared Runners up at the All India Inter University Cricket Championship (For the Rohinton Baria Trophy) at Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh. Later Pulkit captained North Zone universities along with his teammate Rohit Dubery in the Vizzy Trophy organized by BCCI at Mumbai.

Sachin Ruhel B.A I and Rajesh Sharma BA I represented Delhi in under-19 age category in North Zone and All India championship organized by BCCI in both formats i.e. limited overs and days tournaments. College team participated in four Inter college tournaments and in three 20-20 versions Red Bull, GMR Delhi daredevils cup and Shivaji College cup were placed runners up in Delhi. In all these tournaments the college team was placed Runners – Up.
