

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

The College infrastructure witnessed a massive improvement during this year. Three additional floors were added to the under-construction permanent academic and office buildings and with that the entire structure is now complete. Interior works are underway and these buildings shall be of use during the next academic session.

Many improvements and additions, small and large, were implemented in the existing buildings. The large ones include solar power generation (180 KW), one elevator each for the two buildings, remodeling of the sports field (that we initiated and the RLA college is completing) a roof over the canteen dining area and designing and creation of the Student Activity Room.

The smaller augmentation concerns creation of an Incubation Centre, a Language Laboratory-cum-recording room and a room designated for NCC and NSS. The accounts and administrative offices have been redesigned and provided with compactor storage systems. The medical room, placement cell and NAAC office were upgraded, and new signage was installed at the gate, boundary wall and in the buildings. Paving of the parking area and a sitting area beside the canteen, creating a recreational badminton court, provision of display boards for all societies and interactive boards in four rooms are some other notable additions.

Environmental concerns have been addressed through the installation a water management system and composting chambers for garden waste and sensor operated lighting in open spaces and toilets and connecting the entire sports field to the existing water harvesting system. [It may be noted that now over 90% of the land area with the college is under the rain water harvesting system.]

The buildings have become safer and more user-friendly with firefighting equipment, light sensor operated lighting in toilets and outdoors, tactile flooring and braille signage.

INSTITUTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

In less than a decade, Aryabhata College has made an incremental progress, growing as it is by leaps and bounds in academics and extra-curriculars as well as in sports. The present annual report is a testimony to that spirit of excellence that drives Aryabhata College.

- ❖ In one of the major achievements of the concluding academic year was the announcement of NAAC grade; years of dedication, months of planning combined with consistent efforts and the excellent team work resulted in Aryabhata College being accredited with A+ with CGPA of 3.38 on a four point scale in its first cycle of NAAC assessment.
- ❖ Aryabhata College was ranked within top 100 colleges of India as per India Today Ranking 2022: 77 for B.Sc. Courses, 78 for Art Courses and 82 for Commerce Courses; all of which is a matter of great pride for us an institution as well as hugely motivating.
- ❖ Our College has been selected as one of the centres of Bharatiya bhashas – ‘Sindhi Bhasha Kendra’ for two years under the prestigious initiative by Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS), Ministry of Education, GOI.
- ❖ Our persistent efforts and large number of cadet applications eventually bore fruits in 2022 – 7 Delhi BN NCC two platoons (108 seats) were awarded to Aryabhata College.
- ❖ Aryabhata College is now a recognized publication house. It was approved and allocated 10 ISBN during financial year 2022. The Aryabhata College University of Delhi (ACUD) publication house has already published one book on Article 370, and another is forthcoming on ‘Vishwa Guru Bharat: Use of Indian Knowledge in Developing Interventions and Innovations for Contemporary World.’
- ❖ With the aim to equip and train teachers for VACs under National Education Policy (NEP) for undergraduate programme, a series of workshops were successfully held in college in collaboration with Mahatma Hansraj Faculty Development Centre, Hansraj College (An initiative under, Ministry of Education, Government of India).

- ❖ A two-day ICSSR National Seminar on Vishwa Guru Bharat – Use of Indian Knowledge in Developing Interventions and Innovations for Contemporary was held in collaboration with Bharatiya Shikshan Mandal in December 2022.
- ❖ It is a matter of great pride for us that our colleagues were promoted, and some were also selected as faculty members at various levels in other institutions; Dr. Devender Singh was promoted as Associate Professor, and has been selected as Associate Professor in the Department of English, University of Delhi. Dr. Vibhuti Gaur was selected as Associate Professor in IGNOU. Dr. Shiv Poojan Pathak joined the Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, on deputation basis. Three other faculty members - Dr. Aastha Ahuja, Dr. Birender Kumar, Dr. Shiv Poojan Pathak were promoted to next level. Moreover, Mr. Abhishek Parashar, a former adhoc employee of our College was selected as Assistant Professor for permanent appointment at Hansraj College, University of Delhi. In a further happy turn of events, the interviews for permanent appointments in our College is scheduled to begin in the first week of May with many more in the wings.
- ❖ Three new Add-on courses were initiated during this academic year: ‘Advance Programming in Financial Modelling’ and ‘Business Analytics Course’ were introduced in collaboration with IMS Pro-school and under the certification of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, GOI and National Stock Exchange (NSE). ‘Mind Your Wellness: a course on mental well-being’ was also initiated in collaboration with Unique Psychological Services under the aegis of Ministry of Corporate Affairs, GOI.
- ❖ Some College faculty members were awarded with a major & minor projects namely, ICSSR research project and another one under Institute of Eminence scheme, Delhi University.
- ❖ Gandhi Study Circle's proposal to hold an international seminar on the theme, ‘Gandhi and his critiques: A Contemporary Discourse’ has been accepted by Indian Council of Philosophical Research (ICPR) for financial support in form of Seminar grant of Rupees Seven Lakh and Fifty Thousand Only. The college proposes to hold this international event for three days on the occasion of the Gandhi Jayanti from 2nd October to 4th October 2023.

- ❖ IGNCA and its partners gifted Students Activity Centre to Aryabhata College in lieu of the research partnership between IGNCA and Aryabhata College for *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav* project MoU signed with of the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India.
- ❖ The Fee Concession and Scholarship Committee of Aryabhata College invited applications from interested students. After a rigorous procedure of interaction, the Committee awarded 62 Students with Scholarships under various categories. In addition to that 85 students were selected for Fee Concession to fuel and to help the deserving and the underprivileged achieve their passion for education.
- ❖ In a spirit of gratitude and paying back to the institution, Dr. Devender Singh, Associate Professor at Dept. of English (Delhi University) instituted a fellowship - Smt. Pista Devi Memorial Fellowship – and contributed an amount of Rupees Three Lakh towards Endowment Fund of Aryabhata College towards promotion of education for all.
- ❖ Aryabhata College in collaboration with IGNCA participated in three-day Diwali festival programme – DEEPOTSAV - where students organised and participated in various cultural activities and received recognition for the same.
- ❖ Department of Hindi organised and celebrated Hindi diwas under the aegis of *Rajyabhasha Karyanvan Samiti* and Hindi Sahitya Parishad via Hindi *Pakhwada*– a week-long event which included numerous activities to promote our national language.
- ❖ In its indefatigable efforts to get our students best placement and career opportunities, the Placement and Internship Cell brought under its roof several reputed companies including Axis Bank, BookMyShow, 1Lattice, CarDekho and Tophire during recruitment drives. Among its other commendable activities, the Cell organized a meet with the Ambassador of Costa Rica - Dr. Claudio Ansorena Montero who visited the campus for student interaction.
- ❖ The Cell conducted its Annual Internship Fair - " Agnito 3.0" in the month of April 2023 where more than 40 companies visited the campus for recruiting students. Students were provided with a diverse range of internship, job and volunteering opportunities. The fair was attended by more than 500 students from different universities.

- ❖ The University of Delhi has launched Career Development Centres (CDC) in various colleges of the University of Delhi in association with Samarth Bharat. Towards this initiative, the MOU was signed by Professor Manoj Sinha, Principal, Aryabhata College in the presence of Mr Vikas Gupta, Registrar, University of Delhi.
- ❖ The college has duly established Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) in the institute, under the aegis of Ministry of Education and has been playing an instrumental role in architecting and driving the entrepreneurial ecosystem in the campus.
- ❖ Another significant MoU was signed by the College with Bhatt Foundation to forge financial support system for the weaker section of students, cultural exchange and empowerment of girl et al.
- ❖ The College has initiated Peer-Support Programme – SAHAYANA under Department of Psychology where students are trained by experts to be Peer supporters and help distressed students in college.
- ❖ “Euphony 2023” under the aegis of Finance & Investment Cell (FIC) Aryabhata College has been ranked as the 10th Best Festival for Financial Awareness at national level by UNSTOP Awards.
- ❖ The College has created an Endowment fund of Rs. 49.60 Lakhs through owing to its assiduous efforts and the generous benefactors.
- ❖ The College was covered by Times of India, national newspaper, and by Hugo Barcia, India & South Asia Bureau Correspondent of Spanish News Agency EFE, among other wider public coverages.
