*****INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT*****

The College infrastructure witnessed a sea change over the years since we started in 2014. Almost all of the college infrastructure visible today has been created over the past decade of our existence – thirty classrooms, six tutorial rooms, four laboratories, a two-storey library, two office halls, a staff room, a seminar room and a multipurpose hall, an evaluation centre and a research centre, a language laboratory and a room to coordinate the activities of the NCC, NSS and the Student's Council, a canteen and a utility centre, a stepped lawn, paved parking, and external walkways. The previously existing old office block has been wholly reworked to provide three conference/committee rooms, a medical room, an additional laboratory and a placement room.

The newly created infrastructure is mostly disabled friendly, except for one hall, and is wholly covered by rain-water harvesting systems and rooftop solar power is installed to cater fully to the existing power load.

A decade later we are well-poised to begin using the new buildings whose construction began in 2018 and which suffered a delay of over two years mainly due to the pandemic. The new buildings open new vistas for the development of the college. With built up space for 35 classrooms, 5 lecture theatres, 20 tutorial rooms, a four-storey library, 10 large laboratories, 10 rooms and two halls for offices and amenities, 25 rooms and 4 halls for departments and college societies the possibilities are immense.

The new seven storied building is almost ready, awaiting certain mandatory permissions and clearance. The college has applied for a loan from HEFA to finance the remaining work on the building and provide for the furnishing and equipment. We hope to bring this infrastructure into use in the coming academic session.

The Sports Ground has been a major highlight in the infrastructural development and is already in use by sports students for a variety of games training, practice and events. That the efflorescence of the institutional facilities has also resulted in many gold, silver and bronze medals that our students have bagged in several inter-university and zonal events and wide-ranging recognition in the last couple of years.

The optimal utilization of the spaces for various societies and cells beyond academic use has provided the students with space and facilities that too has led to greater glory; all of which has resulted in the College being awarded A+ in NAAC accreditation in the first cycle within less than 8 years of its foundation.

*****INSTITUTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS*****

In less than a decade, Aryabhata College has made an incremental progress, growing as it is by leaps and bounds in academics and extra-curriculars as well as in sports. The year in review here is a testimony to that spirit of excellence that drives Aryabhata College. Some of the major institutional achievements of the last year are as follows: -

Dr. Krishna Murari & Dr. Sangeeta Kumari (History), Dr. Dharendra Bahadur Singh (Hindi), Dr. Astha Ahuja & Dr. N M Singh (Economics) and Dr. Preeti M. Gacche in the English department.
- ❖ Dr. Promila was promoted to Assistant Professor Level 12.
- ❖ Among the Non-teaching Staff, 05 staffs were promoted; Mr Pankaj Kumar (Administration) and Ms. Subala Gautam (Accounts) were promoted as Senior Assistant. Mr Purushottam & Ms. Ritu Rana (Library) were promoted as Professional Assistants, and Santosh Bisht (Library) was promoted as Library Assistant.
- ❖ The Psychology department of the College was ranked No. 6 and the College among top 10 emerging science colleges as per India Today Ranking.
- ❖ Aryabhata College University of Delhi Publication published its first book *Vishwa Guru Bharat'' Use of Indian Knowledge in Developing Interventions and Innovations for Contemporary World''*.

Add-on Courses Cell

Add-on Courses Cell has successfully wrapped up several courses during the year, demonstrating a commitment to bolstering students' skill sets and employability. These completed courses encompass a diverse range of subjects. Firstly, the "Mind Your Wellness" program, conducted in collaboration with Unique Psychological Services and certified by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, GOI, spanned 30 hours from March to July 2023. Additionally, the college offered an extensive "Advanced Program in Financial Modeling," in partnership with IMS Pro-School and certified by NSDC and the National Stock Exchange. This comprehensive 100-hour course unfolded from October to May 2023. Moreover, the "Business Analytics Course," also in collaboration with IMS Pro-School and certified by NSDC and the National Stock Exchange, ran concurrently with the Financial Modeling program. Besides these courses, the Add-on Courses Cell organized both online and offline orientation sessions for beginners in Spanish and French languages, partnering with Cervantes Instituto and Alliance Française de Delhi, respectively. Furthermore, Aryabhata College has forged a research partnership with the Centre of Community Medicines, AIIMS, to conduct data collection focusing on mental health literacy and substance abuse. Looking ahead, the committee is actively exploring future course and training options, including IAS preparatory training, scholarship applications for higher education in Australian universities, courses on Digital Marketing and Wealth Management, as well as student exchange and academic partnership programs with Costa Rican universities.

Adventure and Nature Society

In its 35th year, the Adventure and Nature Society conducted a lecture by our alumni and Everester Prem Kumar Singh, an afternoon testing a board game Summit Conquest and a hike to Bhardwaj Lake in Asola-Bhati sanctuary. A post monsoon 5-day Himalayan trek to Dayara and Paula Tona meadows. An introduction to bird identification at Okhla Bird Sanctuary followed by two birding

trips to Okhla and Keoladeo Ghana parks culminated with women members participating in a day-long adventure activities camp at the Indian Mountaineering Foundation.

ENACTUS Aryabhata

Project Ibtida, Palash and Utkarsh continued to attain the three-fold objectives of ENACTUS-targeting environmental concerns, providing market-based solutions as well as uplifting the marginalised groups as its beneficiaries. Utsav's attar infused soy wax candles were put for display and sale as well as ABIR's Holi campaign continued to popularize the use of organic and natural colors yet again this year. Ibtida's agrocrete- the carbon negative building material continued to be an effort in the direction of stubble management. The collaboration with Mr. Seduram improvised innovative dyeing techniques. As did the mentorship in textile waste management from the Paiwand Studio. Skill enhancement sessions were held with the underprivileged women & victims of human trafficking by collaborations with STOP, Prabhaav, Etasha and Khushil NGOs. ENACTUS continued its environment friendly initiatives by collaborating with "Greenbandhu" to make compost out of floral waste and Sri Gyan Vidya Samiti & loom Key as well as Banni Handcrafts to promote use of 100% handloom cotton.

A new addition this year was the production of hemp bags and setting up of a stall for the same on the college campus. The beneficiaries were the women of STOP NGO and the Thousand Dreams Foundation. Project Palash has been working on establishing an efficient composting centre in the college. ENACTUS, Aryabhata has also been trying to expand itself more and venture into something new with Project Arazi that targets enhancing soil health and act on problems arising from land degradation. The project is working on prototyping for fertilisers and pesticides as well. Efforts are also being put to replicate IIT Hyderabad's bio bricks model so as to tackle the issue of stubble burning.

Finance and Investment Cell (FIC)

During the last academic year, the Finance and Investment Cell engaged in a wide array of endeavours, focusing on financial literacy, social empowerment, cultural enrichment, and intellectual discourse. Their flagship project, Project Samarth, aimed to empower underprivileged communities through financial awareness workshops conducted in collaboration with

organizations such as RSVI, Pehchaan Street School, and Shubhakshika. Additionally, a workshop addressing street harassment, held in partnership with Ms. Navya Naveli Nanda, Yuva, and L'Oréal, advocated for inclusivity and societal dignity. The launch of the third edition of their Absolute Advantage magazine, graced by Mr. Subhash Chandra Garg, former finance secretary of India, emphasized the pressing need for financial literacy in today's complex world. Euphony'23 showcased the diverse talents of the college community, fostering cultural unity and celebration. Despite challenges leading to the cancellation of its second day, Finomena 4.0 underscored the Cell's dedication to promoting dialogue on financial strategies and entrepreneurial visions. The Finance Premier League (FPL), an intra-cell competition, and the monthly podcast "Bucks and Banter," exploring topics like gaming industry ethics and marketing strategies, further exemplified the Cell's commitment to entrepreneurship and financial awareness. Intellectual discussions, including the Group Discussion on the Interim Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025, provided platforms for insightful debates on fiscal policies and business strategies, enriching the academic discourse within the college community. Through these initiatives, the Finance and Investment Cell demonstrated its dedication to holistic student development and societal impact.

Gandhi Study Circle

On 29th November in collaboration with Department of Political Science and Department of History under the aegis of IQAC, the society organized a Webinar via zoom. Uday Singh Mehta was the Guest Speaker on the topic Gandhi: Complexity of Violence, while Dr. Tarang Kapoor was the discussant. Around 60 students and faculty members attended the event through online mode and had an interesting discussion. During the month of February, another National seminar on Gandhian Satyagraha for 21st Century supported by ICSSR was organised. This seminar also witnessed huge participation and provided opportunities to Gandhian scholars to discuss Satyagrah, its implications and consequences. Last event of the society this year was a Discussion on Sita Ram Goel's History writing and Ayodhya movement by Dr. Koenrad Elst. The discussion held was a comprehensive review of Goel's contributions to Hindu literature, emphasizing his opposition to Islamic supremacy. Acknowledging Goel's influence on modern

India, the session traced his journey from a Gandhian activist to an anti-communist and a reborn Hindu, leaving an indelible mark on British liberal thinkers.

Gender Sensitisation Committee

The Gender sensitisation Committee started the year by conducting an orientation workshop in collaboration with Internal Complaints Committee on Sensitization, prevention and grievance redressal mechanism at campus. IKS – Shikshan Prashikshan Kendram by Ministry of Education, GOI

During the academic year 2023-24, Aryabhata College was granted IKS Shikshan Prashikshan Kendram for Ancient Indian Mathematics and Indian Astronomy for a tenure of two years. This centre by creating reliable course content on Indian astronomy and Mathematics will create a repository of Indian knowledge easily accessible and understandable to young minds. This project, through availability of course material and training program; will help institutions of higher education to effectively integrate & promote IKS in curriculum and aid in active implementation of NEP. It will serve as a platform for indigenous scholars in critical development of the subject fields. Aryabhata college's IKS centre during this academic year was actively engaged in creating course content for its first subject Ancient Indian Mathematics. During the first phase, the centre conducted workshops to formulate a course and its syllabus by inviting experts from various universities for Ancient Indian mathematics. During its second phase in December 2023 centre curated content for the syllabus formalised by inviting eminent scholars from the field for

recording lectures on the syllabus topics. During the third phase of the project, the centre will be conducting FDP for training teachers effectively in course content of Ancient Indian Mathematics.

Institutional Social Responsibility Committee
