



## FEE CONCESSION AND SCHOLARSHIP

In creating Aryabhata college as an institution which strives for providing resource support for the students, the Fee Concession and Scholarship Committee works consistently towards providing financial economic assistance to its students. The committee ensures that the students are informed about Centre and State sponsored scholarships for seeking assistance from other avenues. This ensures a broader coverage in terms of financial aid available for our students. The committee continually inform students about opportunities regarding financial assistance offered by other organizations.

In this regard the Fee Concession and Scholarship Committee follows a well thought out procedure. The first and foremost step of which is:

- **Information:**

The Committee duly informs students about the disbursement of fee concession and scholarship through college website and notice boards in the campus. In order to avail Fee Concession and Scholarship, Committee invites applications on prescribed forms from students.

- **Scrutiny of Applications**

Committee scrutinizes application to identify incomplete and false applications. The list of eligible candidates is released and called for interview. On the basis of interview conducted the committee assesses financial condition of the students, their academic integrity, attendance consistency and disciplinary conduct. The students are finally then ranked on the basis of their economic need and merit.

- **Authentication of documents furnished by students:**

The students are required to furnish relevant documents to avail scholarship/fee-concession such as Income Certificate, Fee receipt, Aadhar Card and Above Poverty Line Ration Card/

Below Poverty Line Ration Card. The students are also encouraged to disclose any financial distress that they are facing. The focus of the Committee is to ensure that maximum benefits are provided to the most deserving and sincere students.

- **Disbursement of Fee Concession and Scholarship:**

The students are then informed of the decision of the committee and the due amount sanctioned by the committee is duly transferred into their bank accounts.

The College institutes a Student welfare fund (SWF) through which the requirements of more/most needy students are identified and assisted financially.
