Based on presentation and interactive session with the faculty members of the department along with the perusal of Internal Audit reports and Annual Report of the department, the committee has following observations and suggestions:

Observations and Suggestions

- 1. The Department is thoughtfully following a practice of issuing academic calendar, lesson plan and workload preparation/distribution in the beginning of academic session.
- 2. The department has adequate faculty strength to meet the available teaching workload.
- 3. The department conducts admissions in line with the sanctioned student strength for the respective categories.
- 4. The Department is presently offering two undergraduate courses viz. B.Com (Hons.) and B.Com Course.
- 5. The department's faculty profile is up to the mark with necessary upgradations via attending seminars and FDPs. It is advised to increase the research paper publications in the indexed journals.
- 6. There is a need to appoint more faculty members on regular basis. The department has more than half ad hoc teachers of the total strength. It is advised to expedite the process of permanent appointment of teachers.
- 7. The academic result of students graduating from the course is good. It is advised to arrange remedial classes for weak students.
- 8. The number of seminar/workshop/student related activity conducted by the Department is adequate and the same should be practiced in future.
- 9. The use of ICT enabled tools for effective learning process by faculty members is found to be good.
- 10. The use of student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies employed by Department is appreciated.

- 11. The faculty members are adequately mentoring the students on a regular basis.
- 12. The Department shall initiate further steps to conduct/organize programs/workshop in Skill Development for its students.

Overall departmental performance is found satisfactory.
