Observations and Suggestions

- 2. The Department has adequate faculty strength considering the available teaching workload.
- 3. The Department conducts admissions in line with the sanctioned student strength.

- 5. The faculty profile of the Department is good. Department has adequate paper publications and presentations.
- 6. The department mainly has permanent teachers.
- 7. The academic result of students graduating from the course is good.
- 8. The number of seminar/workshop/student related activity conducted by the Department is satisfactory. It is advised to focus more in this area.
