Based on presentation and interactive session with the faculty members of the department along with the perusal of Internal Audit reports and Annual Report of the department, the committee has following observations and suggestions:

Observations and Suggestions

- 1. The course is run via representative faculty members from various departments.
- 2. The practice of issuing academic calendar, lesson plan and workload preparation/distribution in the beginning of academic session is duly followed.
- 3. There is adequate faculty strength to meet the available teaching workload.
- 4. The admissions are carried out in line with the sanctioned student strength for the respective categories.
- 5. The department's faculty profile is up to the mark with necessary up gradations via attending seminars and FDPs. It is advised to increase the research paper publications in the indexed journals.
- 6. The academic result of students graduating from the course is good. It is advised to arrange remedial classes for weak students.
- 7. The number of seminar/workshop/student related activity conducted by the Department is adequate and the same should be practiced in future.
- 8. The use of ICT enabled tools for effective learning process by faculty members is found to be good although need is there for further enhancement.
- 9. The use of student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies employed by Department is appreciated.

10. The faculty members are adequately mentoring the students on a regular basis.

Overall departmental performance is found satisfactory.
