Department of Management Studies, Aryabhata College had organized a seminar on “**Corporate Debt Restructuring Mechanism for Revival of Stressed Companies- Enhancing Asset Quality of Banks**” on **September 15, 2017**. It had turned out to be a highly informative session, which was graced by our honourable speaker, **Prof. R. Venkatraman** (Dean- Institutional Development, ICFAI Business School, Gurugram).



The seminar commenced with a welcome address delivered by our Principal, Dr Manoj Sinha. After that, Dr J. K. Singh, Coordinator, Department of Management Studies introduced the topic of the seminar to the house. He very explained the mechanism of the banking sector in India and the pitfalls of the Indian Banking System. He further argues that the banking sector is the most strategic barometer of any country's economy and it should be strengthened by the timely introduction of reforms.



Prof. R. Venkatraman started the session with insights into the recent status of the Banking Sector and its stringent regulations. He further explained the reason for the need for more stringent regulations in the Banking Sector than other sectors of the economy. In the later stage, he explained the Structure of the Corporate Debt Restructuring (CDR) System and various redesigning plans under CDR. With this, he also represented the change in the quality of Financial Assets of Banks over a period of time in our economy using statistical data of government. Then there was a discussion about the latest decision of RBI of giving HDFC Bank the tag of “*Too Big to Fail*”. With this zeal and enthusiasm, various queries put forth by students were duly clarified by Prof. R. Venkatraman. The session concluded with a vote of thanks extended by Dr Aanchal Gupta, Assistant Professor, Aryabhata College.
