In addition two Economics (hon) first year students (namely Saumil Chautani and Pavni Arora) were working as junior membrs of the Cell during 2020-21 session.
- Our students have played very important role in the excelent performance of the Aryabhatta College 'ENACTUS' in 2020-21. The department is proud of Sahej Kapoor (President), Khushi Joshi (Vice-President), Smriti Bhutani (Research & Development head), Anisha Kalita (Senior Member), Ansh Mehandru (Associate member), Muskan Kathuria (Associate member), Ashwin Kalra (Associate member), Udhav Aggarwal (Associate member), Tanishq Madaan (Associate member), Priyanka Patel (Associate member) for their hard work in 'Project Utkarsh'.
- The students from Economics Department also made crucial contribution towards the work of Entrepreneur Cell of the college. To name a few, Naina Singh (IInd year) worked as president, Sufiya Salim (IInd year) worked as 'Editor in Chief', Tanishq Madan, and Saumil Chautani worked as Associate Members of the cell in 2020-21.
- The students of the department also played significant role in many activities organized by NSS unit of the college. Ms. Geethika Patnaik, B.A. (Hon) IInd year, worked as vice-president of the college NSS unit in 2020-21; and she represented our college at Delhi University level programs in the academic session.

7) Co-curricular Programmes conducted by the Department

- 1. September 2020:
 - Webinar: In the midst of the COVID-19 prevention restrictions the Economic Society of the Aryabhatta College – Mind over Matter organised its first webinar of the academic session 2020-21. The topic of the webinar was "COVID-19 and the future of the Indian Economy". The talk was delivered by Prof. Ram Singh of Delhi School of Economics.
- 2. November 2020:
 - Online Orientation Programme: Due to the impact of COVID-19 pandemic, the orientation program for new students was held only in the month of November.

The new students admitted to the first year were welcomed and inducted into the department.

- 3. February 2021:
 - As a continuous endeavour towards academic excellence a one day webinar was organized by the economic society a part of the society's three days Annual Fest- 'Arthavaad'. There were three sessions in the one day webinar with three eminent speakers on three different topics.
 - The first topic of the webinar was "An Update on India's Real Economy". The speaker for the webinar was Dr. Shamika Ravi, who is a Research Director at the Brookings Centre.
 - The second topic of the webinar was "Union Budget & Economic Survey". The team invited Dr. Krishnamurthy Subramanian, Chief Economic Advisor to the Government of India as a guest speaker.
 - The third speaker for the webinar was Dr. Poonam Gupta, who is a Lead Economist at the World Bank. The topic of the session was "Inflation Targeting in India: An Assessment".
 - Despite the restrictions, the economics society held four inter college competitions 'Knit-your-Niti', 'Ekon-buzz', 'Tradeverse' and 'Seven Days to Die'.
 - The Economics Society was led by Ms. Ritika Nandi as president of the society. There were altogether thirty two students working with her in the society at different capacity in the academic session 2020-21.
 - The Economics Department also published the third edition of the department magazine- 'Viewpoint' on the first day of its annual fest-'Arthavaad' in the month of February 2021. A very vibrant, enthusiastic and hardworking team of students involved in the publication of the annual magazine. The team was led by a third year student Ms. Sana Midha as Editor-in-Chief, and she worked with thirteen other students' altogether which was drawn from all the three batches of B.A. Economics (Hon).
 - The magazine team organized an All India Article Writing Competition for all undergraduates' students in the country on three themes that revolved around hot topics belonging to the subject area of economics. The competition was held completely online amidst the pandemic. Twenty four of our students made contribution for publication in the article section of the magazine.
 - The magazine team also involved in collection of Articles and empirical research reports for the magazine from various departments of our

college as well as from a few other colleges of Delhi University. The whole exercise took months and the long preparations came to an end with a completely changed new 'Viewpoint'.

9) SWOC (Strength , Weakness , Opportunities, Challenges) Analysis of the Department

- 1. Strength:
 - Most faculty members have a PhD. and M. Phil qualification from reputed institutions.
 - The research work in terms of publication is a strong point of the department.
 - Given the COVID-19 pandemic situation participation of some of the faculty members in seminar/workshops is encouraging.
 - Besides academics, the department members, teachers and especially the students are participating in extra-curricular activities including NSS programs both at the college and university level as a representative of the college.

2. Weakness

- Some members of the faculty, although pursuing Ph. D., have yet to complete it. Once they do so, the academic profile of the department would further strengthen.
- Due to COVID-19 pandemic there was a slight down in the participation of seminar/workshops and it needs to be encourage.
- While the students are participating in extra-curricular activities, including the organization of the annual Economics Society festival, such participation is on a limited scale, the department would have to make more efforts to improve upon this.
- There is still need for improvement on documentation of activities that are carried out by the students at the department, intra-college and also at inter college level.
- There is very little extra-campus activity by the students and once the situation permits there is a need for improving upon it.
- There are less interaction with the alumni members and consequently requires significant improvement on this front.

3. Challenges

- In order to better contact and enhance student participation in various activities, there is a need to increase contact with the alumni members of the college and maintain the same both at national and international level.
- In order to better record the activities of the students, there is a need for creating synergy between the faculty members and the students at the department level as well as among the various heads of staff council committees and societies at the intra-college level. Besides this, resources need to be devoted to capturing and recording the activities.

• Improving audio-visual equipment in the college in order to make the teaching and extra-curricular activities more engaging for the students.

10) Future Plans of the Department

- Increase participation in social outreach and community development programmes.
- Provide ample choices to the students for Discipline Specific Elective Papers (DSE) and offering more skill enhancing add-on courses for increasing job prospects and research work.
- Fine-tune lecture delivery and other projects to the emerging audio-visual facilities in the field of education.
- Continuous improvement on department magazine, to help students develop their writing skills and appreciate subject development beyond the classroom.
- Beginning an interview series of eminent personalities of various backgrounds to get valuable insights from their life experience and get inspire the people in general and the young students in particular.
