1. Advanced Financial Literacy

On March 31st, 2023, the Department of Business Economics successfully organized a seminar on Financial Literacy. Ms. Shikha Mittal, the founder of Be.Artsy and winner of IIM Bangalore's Alumni Achiever Award for the year 2019 in the impact category "Social," was the keynote speaker for the event. Ms. Shikha has also been featured in Forbes for the India W-Power Trailblazer in 2019. She is an expert on financial wellness and is on a mission to help others achieve the same. The seminar began with faculty members felicitating Ms. Shikha through a small token of appreciation. Before diving into the topic, a short video clip about Money was shown to the audience. The interaction started with Ms. Shikha asking the audience to express their perspective about money. The conclusion of this question was that it depends on us how we see money; as money is intimate. We need to have control over money, or else money would have control over us. She then went into detail about the three main factors on which earnings of an individual should depend: Needs, Wants, and Desires, explaining how they differ.

Ms. Shikha introduced the audience to the world beyond money and advised them to see the world

through a different lens. She then talked about the eight usages of money: Earn, Guard, Save, Spend, Insurance, Invest, Contribution (Tax and Donation), and Borrow and Lend. This was accompanied by a status quo explanation, showcasing why the particular order of these steps of Financial Planning exist. She made the audience understand that one should borrow only for the betterment or appreciation of an asset and should only lend when he/she is ready to forget about the money lent.

1. Demystifying the UPSC CIVIL SERVICE Examination

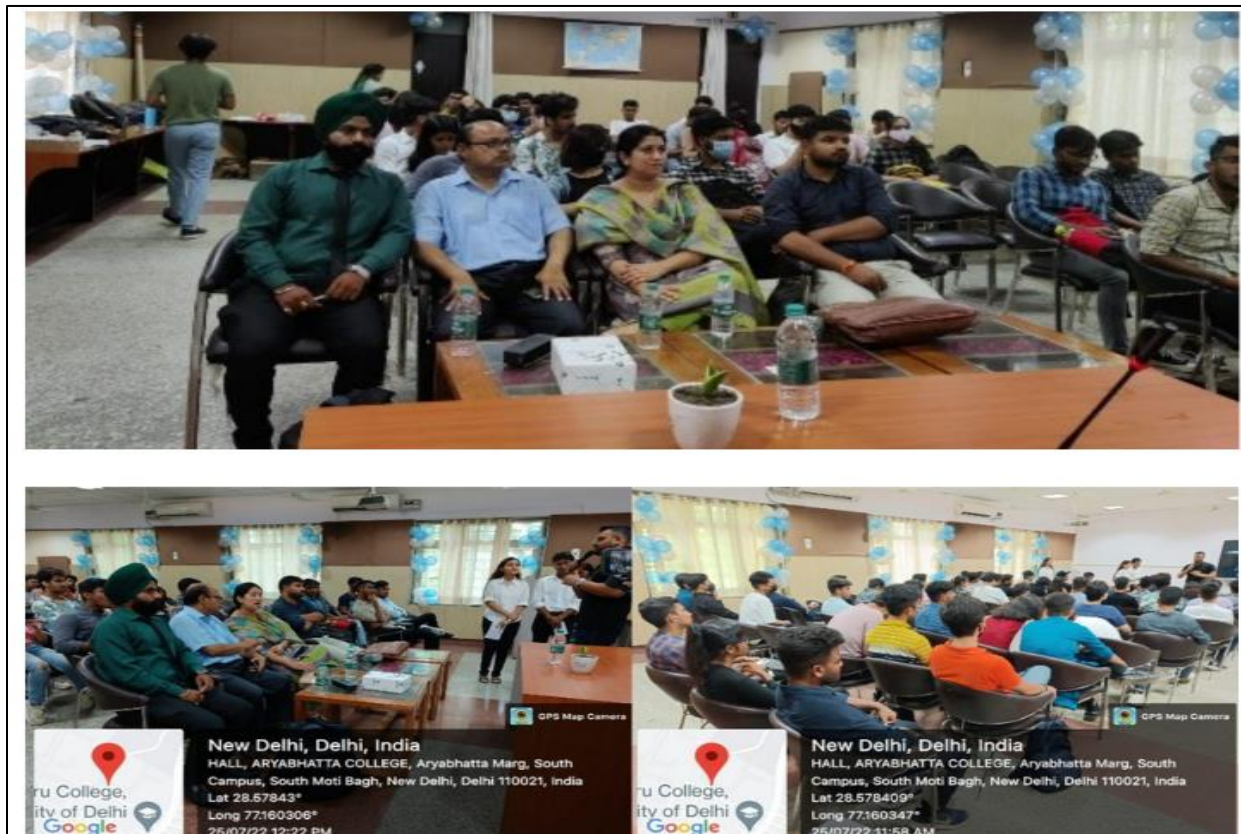
On the 21st of April, 2023, a seminar was conducted on the topic- “Demystifying the UPSC CIVIL SERVICE Examination” in the activity room of a college. The seminar began at 12:30 pm and ended at 2 pm. The speaker of the event was Almas Hussain, who is currently a faculty member at KSG India. Almas Hussain graduated with an Economic Honours degree from the University of Delhi and pursued her Masters in International Political Economy from King's College, London. The seminar was organized to provide insights into various aspects of appearing in the UPSC civil service examination. Almas Hussain began the session with the basic details such as the eligibility criteria, the date for submission of application, details of reservation, scheme of examination, and instructions for filling online applications. The scheme of the UPSC civil service examination consists of three stages- Prelims, Mains, and Interview. While the Prelims are qualifying in nature, the marks obtained in the Mains and Interview stages determine a person's rank. The seminar also had two rounds of discussions on related issues, where students could clear their doubts and seek further clarification. Forty-one students attended the program enthusiastically, and the session proved to be highly informative and helpful for aspirants of the UPSC civil service examination.

In the second half of the event, the audience had the opportunity to ask questions and engage in candid conversations with the speakers. The speakers shared the vulnerabilities and hiccups they

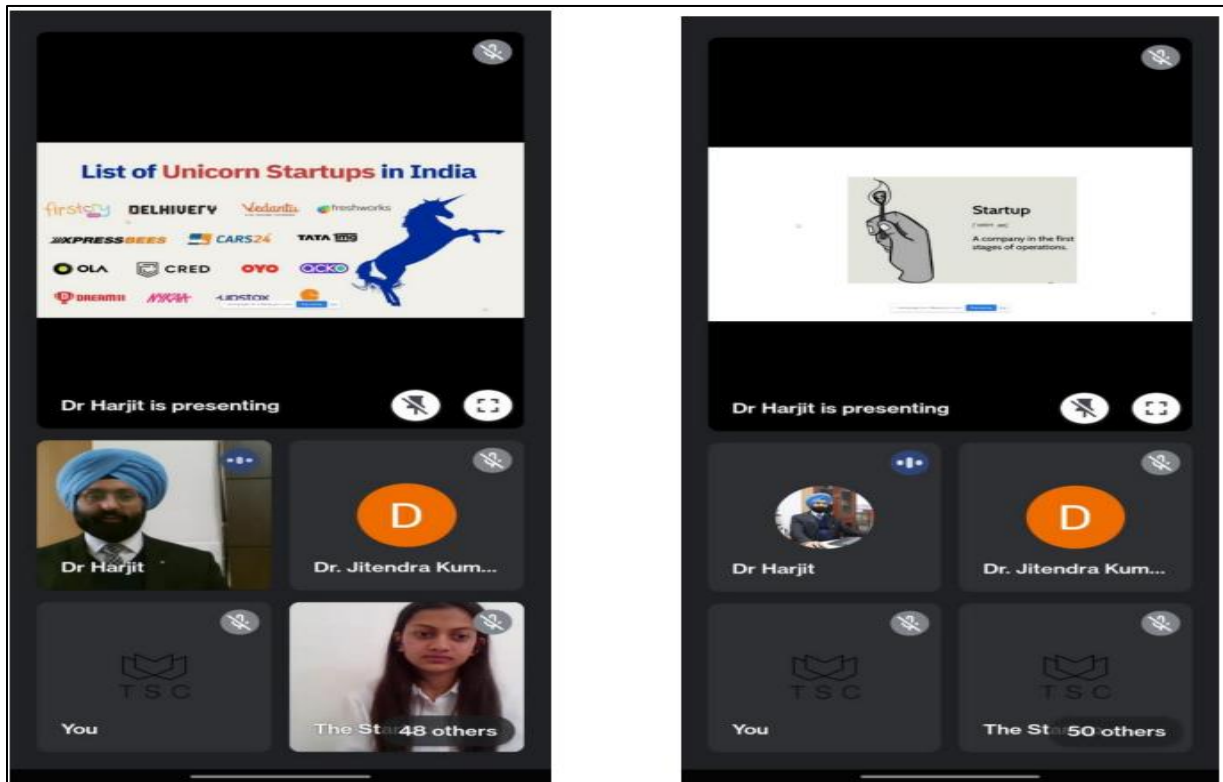
