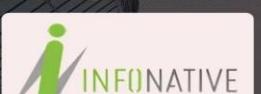

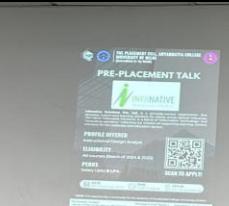

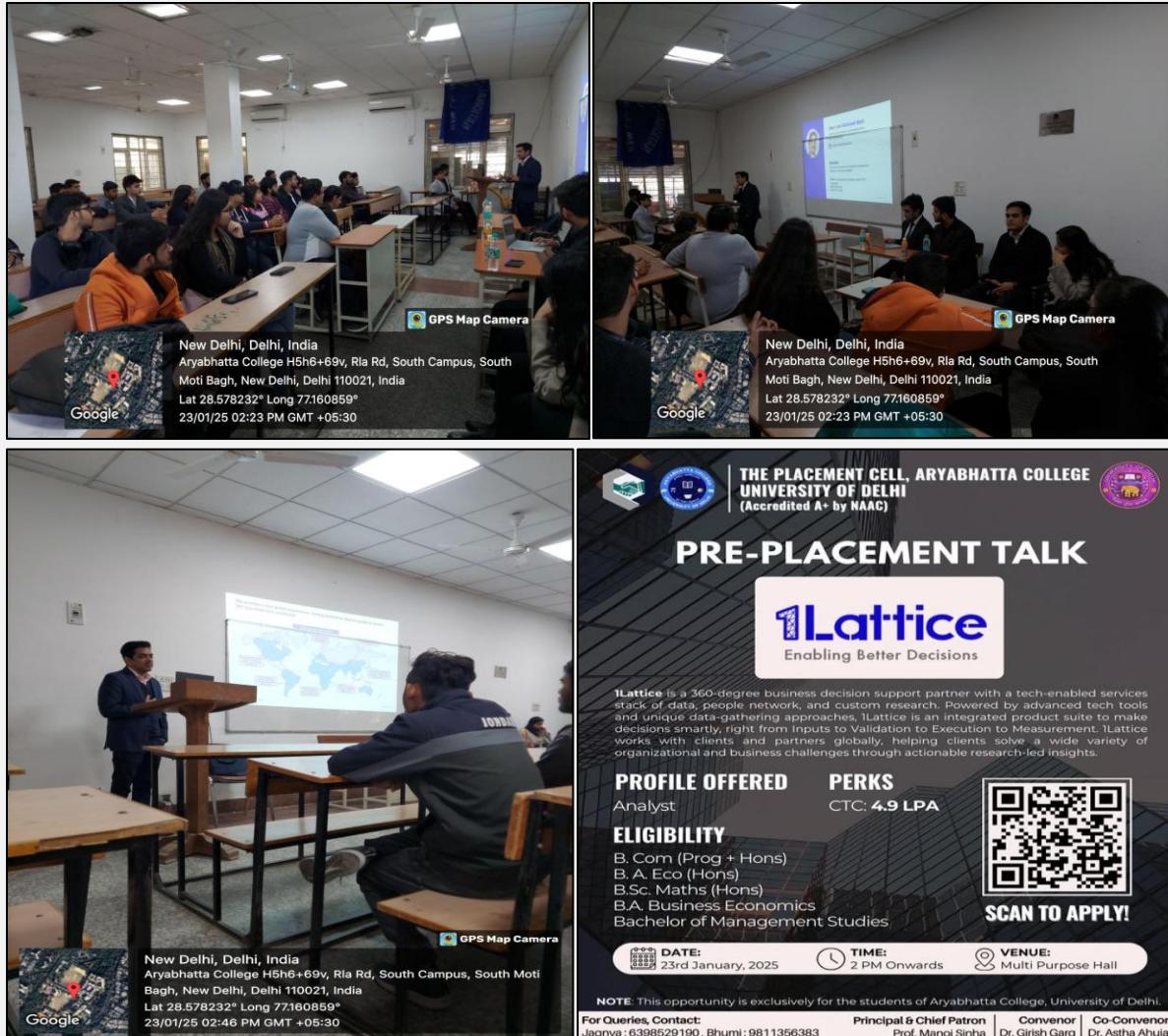

2. Technical Rounds: Technical rounds were conducted to assess candidates' technical knowledge and problem-solving abilities.

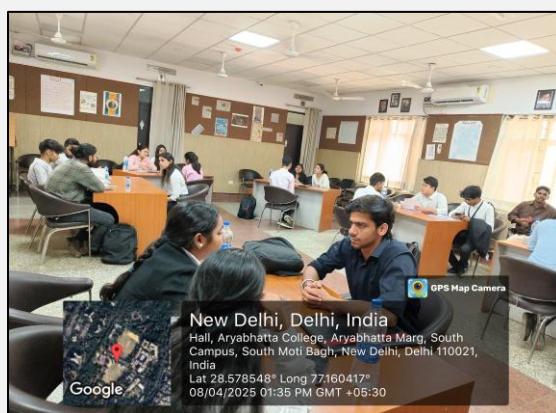
3. Group Discussions: Group discussions were conducted to evaluate candidates' communication skills, teamwork, and ability to think critically.

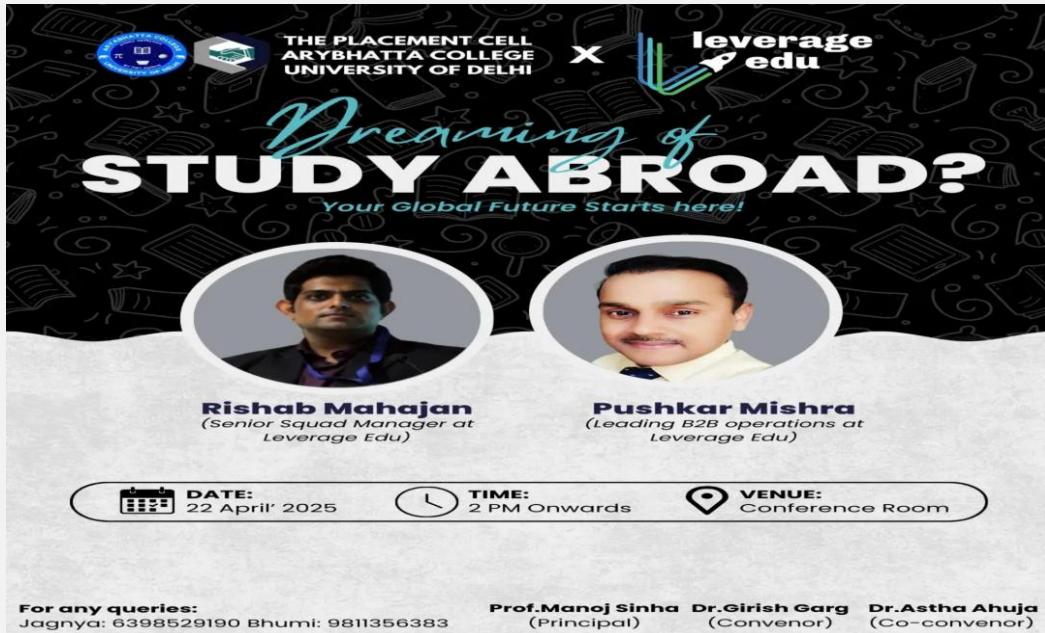
9. SEMINAR: DREAMING OF STUDY ABROAD? YOUR GLOBAL FUTURE STARTS HERE
