1. Project Overview

Project Samarth, initiated by the Finance and Investment Cell of Aryabhatta College, aims to empower underprivileged communities by providing them with essential financial literacy. The project focuses on bridging the gap in financial awareness and fostering upward mobility through knowledge-sharing sessions, workshops, and accessible financial resources.

Project Samarth instills key financial skills, nurturing independence and resilience among the participants. By focusing on inclusive education, it provides individuals with the tools needed for better financial management, creating a ripple effect that uplifts families and communities.

The project was structured around two key collaborations:

- The Rehabilitation Society of the Visually Impaired (RSVI), in June 2023, where financial literacy workshops were conducted for visually impaired individuals.
- Pehchaan Street School, in July 2023, where underprivileged children were taught foundational concepts of finance.

2. **Collaboration with RSVI – June 2023

In collaboration with **The Rehabilitation Society of the Visually Impaired (RSVI)**, the Finance and Investment Cell conducted workshops aimed at empowering visually impaired individuals with financial knowledge. The sessions focused on:

- Basic financial literacy concepts such as saving, budgeting, and managing income.
- Practical insights into debit, credit, and the banking system.
- Providing accessible tools and resources, including audio-based financial education materials, to ensure inclusivity.

Impact:

The collaboration with RSVI helped over [number of participants] visually impaired individuals gain confidence in managing their finances. 3. Collaboration with Pehchaan Street School – July 2023

- The basics of money management, including the importance of savings.
- Understanding the concepts of debit, credit, and the banking system.
- Interactive activities such as role-playing exercises to simulate real-world financial decisions.

Impact:

The workshops were well-received by both the students and the community. The children demonstrated a newfound understanding of financial principles, and their engagement throughout the sessions showed the effectiveness of our teaching methods. The positive feedback from community members further reinforced the significance of this initiative in shaping the future of young minds.
