Highlights of Departmental Activities:

1. Formation of Student Council 2025: (12 August 2025)

The academic session began with the appointment of the BBE Student Council through interviews conducted by faculty members. Key leadership positions, such as President and Vice President, were finalised initially. Thereafter, the elected leadership conducted interviews for the appointment of other posts, ensuring a structured and merit-based selection process.

2. Webinar on Pathways to Data Science: (4th September 2025)

The Department organised an online webinar on 4th September 2025 on “*Pathways to Data Science*”, conducted by Mr Akshay R, Data Scientist at Microsoft. The session provided insights into career pathways in data science, required skill sets, and emerging opportunities in the field.

3. Icebreaker Session: (29 September 2025)

The academic year commenced with an Icebreaker Session on 29 September 2025, organised by BBE Students society, aimed at fostering interaction and engagement among students. The session included fun activities, games, and performances, along with an interactive “Know Your Core” segment introducing the student council.

4. Econoverse - Business Conclave 2025: (11 November 2025)

The department organised Econoverse: Business Conclave 2025 on 11 November 2025, comprising speaker sessions, workshops, and competitions. The event featured Ms Mitali Nikore, a feminist economist, who spoke on Artificial Intelligence and its impact on policy, business, and employment, and Mr Saakshar Duggal, a cybercrime lawyer, who addressed AI crimes, cybersecurity, and digital awareness. A Resume Building & LinkedIn Essentials Workshop was conducted by Mr Aman Kapoor, Senior Professor of Digital Marketing at IIDE - The Digital School, focusing on resume development, LinkedIn optimisation, and personal branding. The conclave also included market simulations and case-based competitions, evaluated by Mr Hitesh Sharma, Founder of EV Leasing, Aftersales & Last-Mile Solutions, and CA Ayush Negi, an esteemed alumnus of the department.

5. Freshers' Welcome Function: (15 November 2025)

The Department organised the Freshers' event to welcome the new batch of BBE students and foster interaction within the department. The event included engaging activities such as interactive sessions, games, dance performances, and a ramp walk competition. The session created a warm and inclusive environment, helping freshers connect with peers and the student council while marking a joyful beginning to their academic journey.

8. Alumni Meet: (14 March 2026)
