These distinguished alumni of Aryabhatta College are now Senior Product Specialist at Hashedin, Project Management Consultant at Capgemini India, and Product Management Consultant at Deloitte respectively.

### **ALUMNI SPEAKER SESSION**

#### (14<sup>th</sup> October 2023)

TechPioneers, the Computer Science Society of Aryabhatta College, successfully conducted a webinar entitled "Getting Ready For Job Placements", on the occasion of National Science Day, 14<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

There were three guest speakers was invited was for the session namely, Mr. Ashish Choudhary, Ms. Smruti Monalisa, Ms. Priya Verma. It was a very informative webinar as all the three speakers enlightened the students with a wide range of topics such as 'CV Making', 'Interview Preparation', 'Technical Skills'.

'Group Discussion' and also share their experiences in corporate sector. The webinar began with a word of appreciation by the principal, Prof. Manoj Sinha. The session saw an overwhelming response from 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students of the college along with interactive Q&A session. The session was attended by 75 participants.

#### **Objective:**

The prime aim of the session was to equip the students with knowledge and understanding of the process which led to corporate sector, highlighting the necessary skills, education, training and experience required to succeed in the field. Additionally, the session also inspired and motivated students to prepare for examinations like CAT and GMAT.

#### Summary of the Webinar:

The speaker Mr. Ashish Choudhary kicks off the session by introducing students with an online community of IIM graduates and industry experts called "DreamIIM", which guide students in preparation of exams like CAT and in getting placements and internships. He also, asked students to develop technical skills and to participate in extra curriculum activities in college tenure, according to their future job requirements.

Adding to that he also gives some insights to students about group discussions and revealed some dos and don'ts about group discussions. Ashish Choudhary also shares his view that how to get select in the job and placement interviews and explained an effective procedure with the audience.

Later, speaker Ms. Priya Verma explained importance of 'CV' to students and guided them that how to prepare a good one. She also pointed out some common mistakes made by candidates while making 'CV' like spelling mistakes and use of passive tone.

Our next Speaker Ms. Smruti Monalisa guided students in resume writing skills and she also introduced students with a website called "OVERLEAF.COM" and also taught full steps to create 'CV' over there. She also advised students to find keywords to put in your CV, according to job requirements.

She also shares some tips that how to stand out the crowd and how to make a good impression on the interviewer.

The webinar concluded with a quick Q&A session. Some of the major questions asked were as follows:

(1) What advice, you would like give to someone who wants to become an entrepreneur?

(2) What are difficulties one can face in switching career from computer science to management field?

- (4) What are the soft skills, a student should develop in college life to get job ready?
- (3) What is the role of profile section in the process of IIM selection?
- (5) How do we handle periods of self-employment or freelance on CV?

To conclude, it was a knowledgeable and interesting session. All the students and teachers thanked all three speakers. The society looks forward to conducting more such webinars in the future.
