
Dr.Roshni CONVENOR A Research Methodology Workshop was conducted on 23 April 2025 from 1:30 to 3:30 PM for third-semester English Honours students. Owing to space constraints, the first half of the workshop took place in the Conference Room, while the second half was held in Room 7 of the Kusumpur Block. The resource persons were Ms. Nitika Gulati from Shyama Prasad Mukherji College and Dr. Roshni from Aryabhatta College.







The workshop comprised two sessions. In the first, Ms. Gulati guided students in drafting a research proposal by formulating a focused research question, articulating its rationale, and outlining a suitable methodology. Employing a movie-pitch analogy, she underscored the importance of intellectual curiosity, structural clarity, and critical framing, supported by examples and templates to aid students in developing meaningful academic inquiries.



In the second session, Dr. Roshni highlighted the significance of proper citation in academic writing. She clarified the distinctions between quoting, paraphrasing, and summarizing, introduced key citation styles (MLA, APA, Chicago), and stressed the importance of avoiding plagiarism. Her session included practical strategies, examples, and tools to support ethical and accurate scholarly documentation.



An additional hour was devoted to hands-on practice, enabling students to craft structured research proposals following MLA citation guidelines. It ended with a Vote of Thanks by Ms. Alka Lahera, the Teacher-in-Charge of the Department of English.
