3. Study Plan

A focused study plan of 20-25 hours per week was recommended, with section-wise preparation strategies:

- **VARC:** Reading comprehension and vocabulary improvement., AEON essays site was recommended to practice Reading Comprehensions.

- **LRDI:** Puzzles and data interpretation.
- **Quant:** Arithmetic, algebra, and geometry topics.

4. Exam Timelines-

The exam timelines for various entrance tests were discussed:

- **NMAT:** Conducted between October and December.
- **CAT:** Held in November.
- **XAT:** Scheduled for January.
- **SNAP:** Takes place in December.
