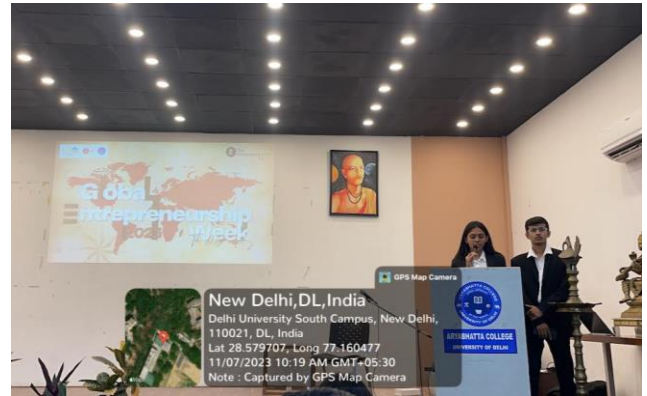
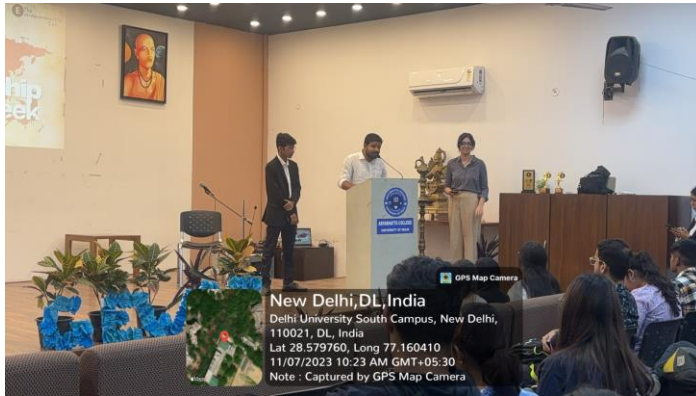

InnoThon was a unique competition that encouraged the participants to innovate their ideas in such a way that supports **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**. This event allowed the participants to showcase their entrepreneurial skills, knowledge, and creativity.

The competition was organized in 3 rounds.

- In the first round, the participating teams pitched their ideas and answered the judges' questions.
- In the second round, the teams participated in a crisis committee.
- The third round was a group discussion among the members of the individual teams themselves who were judged upon their contributions.

InnoThon featured an esteemed panel of judges including **Ms. Vani Dhaka, the founder of The Lantern Tribe**, and **Ms. Nandini Satija, founder of The Samaritan Foundation**, who greatly appreciated the initiative. About our judges, **Ms. Vani Dhaka** is a graduate in Political Science Honors at Kirori Mal College, University of Delhi. In addition to her academic pursuits, she serves as a Research Assistant at Monash University, the University of Glasgow, and LSE. Moreover, she is the dedicated founder of The Lantern Tribe, a community that works towards a more informed tomorrow. Followed by, **Ms. Nandini Satija**, is a College NSDP Fellow, showcasing her academic excellence. She's the founder of The Samaritans Foundation, which helps people struggling with mental health problems. As the Club Advisor for Girl Up Saarthi under the United Nations Foundation, she is a global advocate. She is an LSR alum, a social activist, skilled orator, and a mentor at Ayka Youth Fellowship

The Entrepreneurship Cell of Aryabhata College, University of Delhi, organized the fourth edition of **The High Table - An Intercollege Boardroom Simulation Discussion** on **7th June 2023** in the Seminar Room as a part of the enticing competitions hosted under the celebration of GEW'23. The High Table is a highly interactive platform that aims to provide an opportunity to test the problem-solving and critical-thinking skills of participants through the means of a boardroom simulation.

Four teams from colleges all over India took part in the discussion. The participating teams were from **Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi (IIT), Delhi College of Arts and Commerce (DCAC), Shivaji College and Aryabhata College.**

The event was a boardroom simulation discussion where each team had 3 C-suits: CHRO, CFO, and COO. For each C-suit, a case study was given. A representative from each team gave a solution for the problem stated while another Representative of that particular c-suit could ask them questions. After each team was over with their solution a common solution was found out by mutual discussion. The final discussion was taken by The Elder.

We were joined by the likes of **Ms Palakh Khanna** to judge the discussion and display her knowledge and expertise of the corporate world. About Ms Palakh Khanna, She is a social entrepreneur, TEDx speaker, Mentor, Teacher and Environmentalist.
