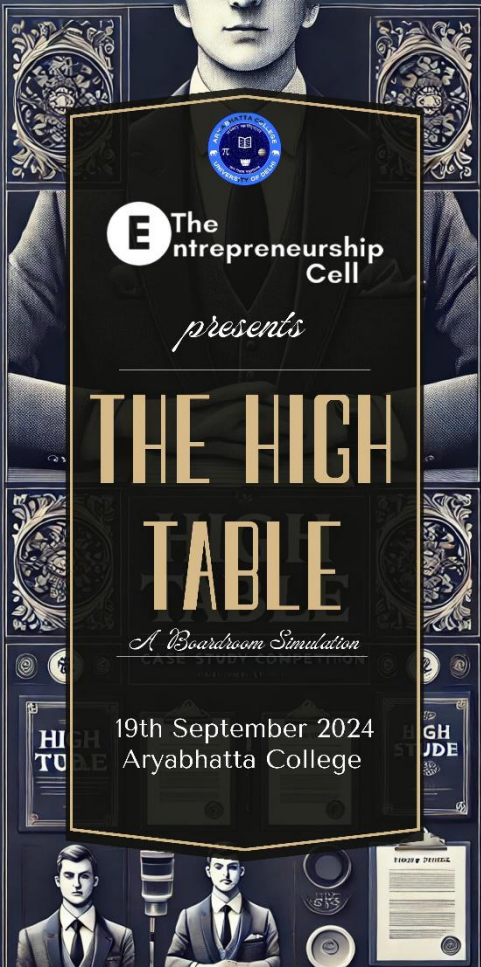

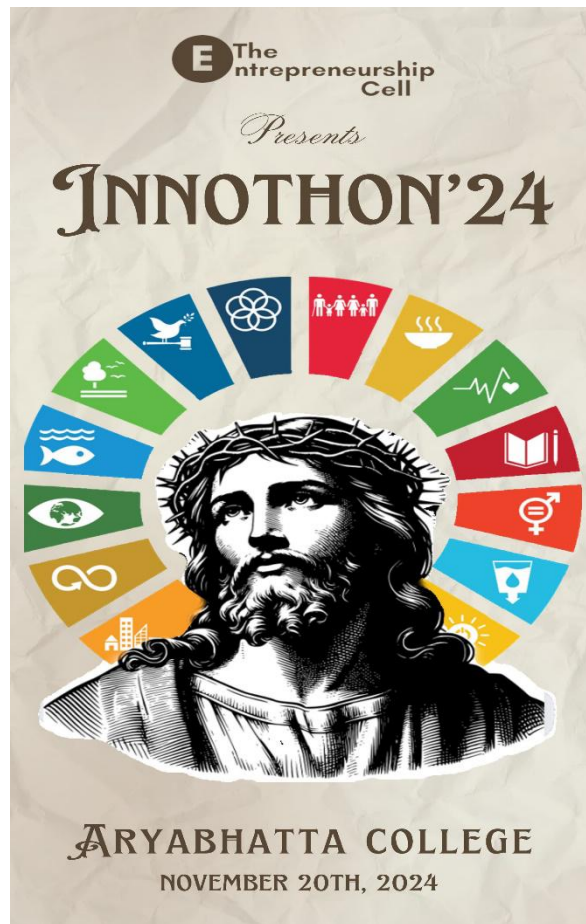

PROPOSED SOLUTIONS

TAXATION ON VDA

The uniform tax rate of 30%, irrespective of the taxpayer's income bracket, along with restrictions such as no deductions beyond acquisition costs, loss set-offs prohibited, and with three percent tax withholding requirements seem all stalling investment into Virtual Digital Assets (VDAs).

Due to these challenges, RBMA will set strategic VDA portfolios with risk management and prudent VDA selection, sophisticated risk assessment, and diversification across several VDAs. This can also be complemented with careful continuous monitoring that ensures compliance yet keeps the tax impact at its lowest minimum.

CLIENT ACQUISITION AND RETENTION

Institutional investors look for asset managers who can help them understand how their portfolios will perform under different scenarios. HNWI's similarly have unique challenges in terms of expertise beyond what most investors require and are hard to recruit as clients. To cater to such needs, RBMA may seek opportunities to offer clients tailored investment products that address specific client requirements by the use of AI and data analytics. Furthermore, online platforms may be created and AI-powered chatbots placed so negotiations with clients are seamless.

EMPLOYING ROBO-ADVISOR

The asset management industry is transforming because of rapid technological innovations, especially in the areas of AI and fintech, by forcing efficiency and refining transparency, along with opening up new opportunities for managers and investors. Managing such swift innovation by staying updated becomes highly necessary because, otherwise, failure to do so could shift younger clients to competitors who provide more superior robo-advisor offerings.

For this, RBMA could opt for a hybrid model wherein human expertise is integrated with AI-driven algorithms. Robo-advisors for initial assessment and AI for market monitoring and rebalancing.
