Apart from these steps, the speaker shared her thoughts and opinions on the questions that were put up by participants. There were also some questions put up by the speaker, which were energetically answered by the students. Additionally, some of the participants from 3rd year were also asked to share their stories demonstrating the interpersonal skills they mentioned in their resume.
